## Village of Cambridge SkatePark

Participants and/or parent/guardian of the skater, if a minor, understand that skating entails unknown risks which simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. The skater/skateboarder/biker agrees to wear appropriate protective equipment when using the Village skatepark. The skater/skateboarder/biker agrees to obey all of the rules and regulations of the facility listed below.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. This skatepark is a "skate at your own risk" space, designed for skateboarding, inline skating and BMX biking only.
- 2. This park has been designed for all skill levels. Be courteous to other park patrons, especially those with less experience. At all time treat each other with respect and use common sense when making decisions, especially ones that will affect others.
- 3. All skaters must have a liability waiver on file before skating. For skaters under 18 years of age, parent/guardian must sign release forms in person or have forms notarized.
- 4. Skateboarding, in-line skating, and BMX biking are high risk activities. Helmets are **REQUIRED** at all times.
- 5. Skaters must be fully clothed. Knee pads are required when wearing shorts.
- 6. Kids under 10 need to be accompanied by someone 14 or older.
- 7. NO MOTORIZED vehicles or other wheeled devices are allowed within the skate park.
- 8. Swearing and abusive language are prohibited.
- 9. No glass is allowed in the park at any time.
- 10. The following are strictly prohibited: littering, glass containers, radios, boom boxes, smoking, alcoholic beverages, other drugs or weapons.
- 11. No food, beverages, candy or gum should ever be on the skating surfaces.
- 12. Fighting or other disruptive behavior will result in loss of skating privileges.
- 13. The Village of Cambridge reserves the right to revoke the use of the skateboard park for participants who are rowdy or do not obey the rules.
- 14. The skate park will be open during posted hours. The Village trespassing ordinance will be enforced when the park is closed.
- 15. Inspect the surfaces before you ride and remove all trash, debris, and any object that may prevent a smooth, safe ride. This is especially important when BMX bikers have been riding.
- 16. Any damage to equipment should be immediately reported to the Village office.

# Breaking any of the above rules may result in the loss of all skating/skateboarding/biking privileges at the skatepark.
